

To say we are jealous is quite the understatement. We LOVE geography in our house. We own a beautiful globe that we consult on a regular basis and we have a 1961 Readerâ [™]s Digest World Atlas. It is fascinating to see how much the world has changed. This wonderful resource is divided into the major continents and the over 200 countries in the world are included under the appropriate continent. But thatâ [™]s not all. The book also groups together countries based on their geographic area. For example, in Europe, the Baltic countries are grouped together (i.e., Estonia, Latvia, & Lithuania) as are the Low Countries (i.e., Belgium, Luxembourg, & Netherlands). This book has already settled an on-going debate in our family: Is Russia part of Europe or Asia? Think you know?Each country has a

two-page spread which features amazing photographs, a map, country facts, an overview of facts, major attractions, geographical information including national bird, tree, and mammal, and 5 Cool Things To Do. Seriously, I could spend all day reading! Of course I had to take a close look at Canada to see what they said. I liked how they had information about the diverse areas of Canada, but I have to say that I was disappointed that the Maritime area (representing 4 provinces) was excluded. But, I also understand that you can only cover so much in 2 pages! Overall, I loved the layout of the page and the information provided was interesting and probably just the right amount of information for my children.My Bottom Line:The Ultimate Globetrotting World Atlas by National Geographic Kids is AWESOME!
